Information Brochure

K.G. Medical University U.P., Lucknow shall be conducting the Competitive Entrance Examination for selection of Candidates for admission to Diploma in Psychiatric/Mental Health Nursing Course (DPN) in Institute of Nursing, K.G. Medical University Lucknow for the year 2018.

- (i) The candidate must be an Indian National.
- (ii) Maximum numbers of seats are **10** (General- 5, OBC-03, SC/ST- 02) as per university guidelines
- (iii) Minimum qualification for admission to Diploma in Psychiatry/Mental Health Nursing i.e. Registered Nurse and Registered Midwife or GNM or equivalent Course from a university recognized by the UGC with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate for Unreserved (UR) and OBC. For SC/ST minimum of 45% marks in aggregate is essential.

(1) Application and Examination Fee

Candidates for the entrance test will have to pay a fee of **Rs. 2000/- for Gen & OBC** and **Rs. 1200/- for SC/ST** payable through Allahabad Bank or HDFC Bank. **Examination Fee shall be submitted with prescribed application form and online only.** No application form shall be received by post.

Official Bank for submission of Fee is Allahabad Bank and HDFC Bank (Any CBS branch in India or by Master / Visa Card)

(2) Payment of examination fee:

- (A) By Credit card /Debit card (Master/Visa card only) or Net banking from 1st June, 2018. Candidate can directly proceed the filling of application form after payment.
- (B) Candidate can also deposit cash through bank Challan of Allahabad Bank/ HDFC Bank till **12th July 2018.** For this, first download bank Challan from website www.kgmu.org and deposit the examination fee in any branch of Allahabad Bank or HDFC Bank branch in India. The Candidate will be provided a receipt with transaction ID number on its deposition. It is required to upload scan copy of this Bank receipt with the transaction ID for filling the application form. In case of payment by bank Challan, candidate is required to re-login with their login ID and Password. Two working days after making payment, candidate will be able to fill the application form. Candidate is required to keep scanned copy of bank receipt ready for the filling of the application form at this stage.

- (C) The application form complete in all respect should reach up to **16th July 2018 (Monday)**. *(Incomplete forms and the forms received after the due date shall be rejected)*
- (D) Candidates, who are employed, must submit their applications through proper channel. In case the candidate is selected for the course, he shall be given admission only if he/ she have obtained the permission from his/her employer and the prior sanction of study leave for the entire duration of the DPN Course.
- (E) The candidate should himself make sure about his eligibility for the course and carefully fill up the application form.
- (F) No letter of acknowledgment of the receipt of application shall be sent to the candidates.
- (G) The processing fee once received shall neither be refunded nor adjusted for subsequent examination.
- (H) Candidate should take a printout of his Application form and recheck it.

All documents pertaining to eligibility, caste certificate etc. shall be checked in original at time of counseling/admission. No documents to be sent at the time of submission.

3. Examination-

- (a) *The written examination for admission in DPN Course shall be held on – 29th, July, 2018 (Sunday) at 11.00AM to 2.00PM. The center shall be intimated in the admit card.*
- (b) The written examination shall consist of 200 Objective/Multiple Choice type questions. The candidates will get 3 hours to complete the full paper. The question paper shall consist of wide range of topics from syllabus of R.N. & R.M/GNM. The written examination will be in English and there shall be no negative marking.
- (c) Candidates 4 times the number of seats shall be called for interview from the merit list prepared. In case of tie of marks, all candidates with same merit will be called for interview.
- (d) *Interview shall start at 11:00 AM on 13th August 2018 and/or 14th August, 2018 (Monday & Tuesday) in the Pariksha Bhawan (PHI building), K.G. Medical University, Lucknow. Any change of interview date shall be notified to the candidates.*
- (e) Candidate shall be required to produce original mark sheets and other testimonials at the time of interview.
- (f) The final merit list will be prepared by adding marks obtained in the qualifying examination, in Theory and Interview.

In case of tie the preference will be given in following order

1. Higher marks obtained in Theory.
2. Higher age (older)

The candidates shall himself arrange for his boarding and lodging during his stay at Lucknow for the said examination. No T.A./D.A. shall be permissible for appearing in this examination.

4. Admission:

The selection shall be done by merit list made on the basis of Diploma (Psychiatric Nursing/Mental Health) Entrance Examination-2018-19.

The candidate, who has qualified for the admission to the Diploma (Psychiatric Nursing/Mental Health) course, shall deposit the prescribed fee on the date notified for that purpose by the University. Those who fail to do so will lose their claim for admission to the course.

Candidates shall join the course within the specified period.

5. Important

In case of any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be Lucknow Courts and Judicature of Allahabad High Court, Lucknow Bench only.

The rules and regulations laid down can be reviewed by the University from time to time.

Controller of Examinations

Instructions for Candidates

- i. Candidates will be allowed to enter the examination hall only on production of Admit Card.
- ii. Candidates are required to be present at the examination center 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination and to be seated 10 minutes before the time of examination.
- iii. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination center 15 minutes after the seating time. Candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall only after completion of examination.
- iv. Candidates shall sign the attendance sheet when directed to do so by the invigilators.
- v. Candidates shall not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written matter or bits of paper or any other material except the admit card inside the examination hall. Pagers, cellular phones and gadgets of any kind are strictly prohibited in the examination hall and shall be treated as use of unfair means. Candidates are advised not to bring these to the Examination Hall as there is no provision for safe keeping.
- vi. Candidates shall observe strict silence and attend to their paper. Any disturbance in the examination shall be deemed as misbehavior and the defaulting candidate shall forfeit the right to continue in the examination hall. The decision of the Chief Invigilator shall be final.
- vii. Candidates shall enter the roll number on the top of the question booklet and the response sheet and nowhere else. Rough work, if any, may be done on the question booklet and not on the response sheet.

- viii. The question booklet along-with the response sheet will have to be deposited with the Invigilator of the examination hall after the completion of examination.
- ix. No candidate should leave his/her seat in the examination hall without the permission of the Invigilator until he/she finally submits the question booklet and response sheet to the invigilator.
- x. No candidate shall copy from the paper of any other candidate or permit his/her own papers to be copied or attempt to give or attempt to obtain irregular assistance of any description.
- xi. USE BALL PEN ONLY (BLUE OR BLACK) which is provided,
- xii. Candidate should ensure that the question booklet provided to him contains all the pages intact within 10 minutes of commencement of examination.

Failure to maintain the discipline and to observe these instructions at the time of examination/interview/admission shall disqualify the candidate from taking the present examination/interview/admission and also from subsequent examinations.
