PDCC Course for Academic Session 2018-19

Duration of Course:

1. One year for post graduates MD/DNB.
2. Two year for Diploma candidate.
3. During one year 150 hrs theory teaching consisting of systemic lectures, seminars, symposia and 300 hrs clinical posting in wards, practical demonstration.

Eligibility Criteria:

Eligibility Criteria/Admission Requirements: Post Graduate candidates possessing MD/DNB in Anaesthesiology/Medicine/Paediatrics or Pulmonary Medicine or post graduate Diploma recognized degree by MCI.

Mode of Admission:

1. Will be on qualifying entrance test conducted by the University.
2. Service candidates will be preferred over non-service candidates.
3. If more than one candidate has same eligibility criteria, senior by age will be given Preference.

Course Fee:

Annual as is prevalent in other super specialty departments of the University

Reservation Policy:

1. PDCC is a post MD/MS Superspeciality course.
2. Reservation policy as in prevalent in other Superspeciality (DM/MCh) Program.

On line Application procedure

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Application shall be submitted online only, admit card will be available online it self.
2. Online Application can be submitted on website www.kgmcindia.edu, www.kgmu.org
3. First register and create Login ID and Password on the website as directed and keep it for all future correspondence.
4. Fill all the entries in the application form carefully and check them before final submission as wrongly filled, incomplete application form will be rejected and no enquiry will be entertained regarding this.
5. Please take a printout of the completed application form.
6. Login with the same Login ID and Password will be required for obtaining the Admit Card

Examination-

1. Candidates will be allowed to enter in the examination Hall only on presentation of admit card.
2. Examination will be of **180 minutes** duration and will start at **11:00 AM to 2.00 PM**.
3. Candidates are required to be present at the examination center **60 minutes** before the commencement of the examination and to be seated 30 minutes before the time of examination.
4. No candidate will be allowed to enter in the examination hall **15 minutes** after the seating time. Candidate will be allowed to leave the examination hall only after completion of examination.
5. Candidates shall sign the attendance sheet when directed to do so by the Invigilators.
6. Candidates shall not be allowed to carry any textual material, printed or written matter or bits of paper or any other material except the admit card inside the examination hall. Pagers, cellular phones and electronic gadgets of any kind are strictly prohibited in the examination hall and shall be treated as use of unfair means. **Candidates are advised not to bring these in the Examination Hall as there is no provision for safe keeping.**
7. **Examination will be on MCQ basis (200) in English language only.**
8. **The MCQ will have "One Correct option". There shall be no Negative Marking.**
9. **Subjects/Questions for the written test shall be MD/DNB, Anesthesia Course level. Questions regarding ethics, statistics etc may also asked.**
10. Candidates shall observe strict silence during their paper. Any disturbance in the examination hall shall be deemed as misbehavior and the defaulter candidate shall forfeit the right to continue in the examination hall. The decision of the **Center Superintendent** shall be final.
11. **Candidates shall enter the roll number on the top of the question booklet and no where else. Rough work, if any, may be done on the question booklet and not on the response sheet.**
12. **The question booklet along with the response sheet have to be deposited with the Invigilator of the examination hall after the completion of examination.**
13. No candidate should leave his/her seat of the examination hall without the permission of the Invigilator until he/she finally submits the question booklet and response sheet to the invigilator.
14. No candidate shall copy from the paper of any other candidate or permit his/her own papers to be copied or attempt to give or attempt to obtain irregular assistance of any description.
15. The question **booklet and response** sheet are not to be taken out of the examination hall under any condition.
16. **USE BALL PEN ONLY (BLUE OR BLACK) provided by us.**
17. Candidate should be careful while filling the circle provided in the answer sheet. The answer sheet shall be read by **OMR** Technology and marks awarded shall be final and no representation shall be entertained.
18. Candidate should ensure that the question booklet provided to him contains all the pages intact within 10 minutes of commencement of the examination.

Rules & Regulations

1. Admission to PDCC Course will be made on the basis of Entrance examination scheduled to be held on **18 August 2018, at KGMC Lucknow.**
2. **Payment of Examination Fee:**
 - (A) By Credit card /Debit card (Master/Visa card only) or Net banking till 14 August 2018. Candidate can directly proceed filling of application form after payment.
 - (B) Candidate can also deposit cash through bank Challan of Allahabad Bank/ HDFC Bank till 12 August 2018. For this first download bank Challan from website www.kgmu.org and deposit the examination fee in any branch of Allahabad Bank or HDFC Bank branch in India. The Candidate will be provided a receipt with transaction ID number on its deposition. It is to be required upload scan copy of this Bank receipt with this transaction ID for filling the application form. In case of payment by bank Challan candidate will require re-login with their login ID and Password. Two working days after making payment, candidate will be able to fill the application form. Candidate required to send scanned copy of bank receipt ready for the filling the application form at this stage. No T.A./D.A. will be paid for attending the Entrance Examination/Interview/Counselling.
3. Any dispute in regard to any matter referred to herewith shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Allahabad High Court of Judicature, Lucknow Bench only.
4. The decision of the Vice-Chancellor shall be final in the matter of selection of candidates for admission to the course and no appeal shall be entertained on this subject.
5. There is no provision for rechecking of answer sheets or communication of marks obtained at the Entrance Examination. Result of the entrance shall be available at the website of the University.
6. **Scrutiny: However scrutiny is permissible on payment of Rs 500/- in either of the Bank Account mentioned or by Demad Draft in favor of “KGMU Paramedical Entrance Examination ” payable at Lucknow. The candidate can opt for scrutiny witin 48 hours of declaration of the result.**
